For more information on **Property Standards**, Official Plan, Outdoor Furnace information, Building Permit fees etc., please visit our website at www.laurentianhills.ca and then click on Building and Planning.

Please discourage children from playing on snow banks near the streets. Vehicles and plows may not be able to see children and be able to stop in time.

Please take note that effective December 1, 2013 **winter parking restrictions** are in effect. These restrictions prohibit parking a vehicle on any street, highway or Municipal boulevard in such a manner as to interfere with Town services such as snow plowing or the removal of snow and ice. Comply to avoid being ticketed or towed.
