Any vehicle OR trailer	\$10
Any vehicle AND trailer	\$20
Trucks larger than one ton*	\$12/cu yd
Hydrocarbon contaminated soil**	\$15/cu yd
Scrap metal cardboard, blue box items	free
All tires on or off rims	free
Household Hazardous waste	free
Electric and electrical equipment	free
Brush	free
Leaf, grass, garden waste (separated from brush)	free

*Fees for mattresses, stuffed couches, chairs, love seats etc must be paid and are per item **Must have completed analysis and be approved by the Coordinator (613-584-9194) **Fees can be paid at the Bagg's Road site or Town office.**

No owner or person in charge of **any animal** shall allow the animal to defecate anywhere on property unless the owner ensures that the excreta are removed and disposed of in a sanitary manner. By-law No. 14 – 05 Failure to comply is subject to a penalty. **A reminder to NOT let your dogs or cats on beaches or playgrounds and be sure to NOT let them roam freely.**

Cheques for taxes and water payments may be left in the night deposit box in Chalk River at 19 Railway or in Point Alexander 34465 Highway 17 at the main office. The Municipality **will not** be responsible for cash left in the drop box.

TAX INSTALMENT DUE DATES

The first installment date was due **February 21** and the second installment date of the Interim tax billing is due **May 23, 2013.**

WATER/SEWER BILLING

The January/February billing was due February 28, 2013.

The March/April billing is due April 30, 2013.

MILLER ROAD C&D WASTE DISPOSAL SITE HOURS

Tuesday to Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Permits must be obtained from Deep River Town Office during their regular business hours. Construction and demolition waste is defined as all non-hazardous low metal content waste from construction and demolition clean up projects, consisting primarily of; wood, blocks/stone/bricks, non-metal roofing material, insulation, waste furniture (does not include mattresses and box springs), window glass, non metal siding material, concrete and small amounts of plastic and fiberglass. Carefor Volunteers will help with Income Tax Returns

Volunteers trained by Canada Revenue Agency will be available from March 4 to April 5 to assist individuals on limited incomes with their income tax returns again this year. This includes, but is not limited to, students, new immigrants, pensioners, recipients of social assistance and individuals on disability pensions. For the purposes of this program, limited income is defined as \$30,000 for an individual, and \$40,000 for a couple, with an additional \$2,500 allowed for each child. **This assistance is available till April 5. There will be no extensions so be sure to get your information in early.** Tax forms may be dropped off at the Municipal Offices in Point Alexander and Stonecliffe, or the Long Term Care Facility in Deep River between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., from Monday to Friday. They may also be dropped off at 49 Joseph Street in Chalk River. This is a free service sponsored by the Carefor Health and Community Services. Open air fires are **NOT** allowed from **April 1st to October 31st.**

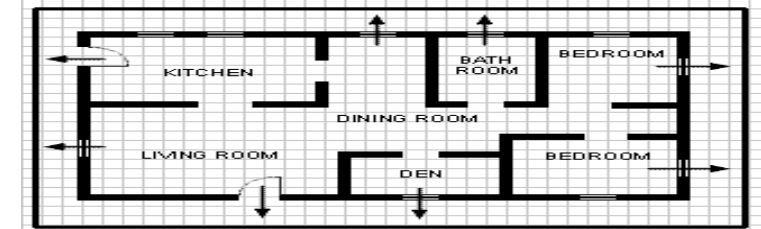
The Fire Chief requests that you verify that it is an emergency and **not a controlled burn** before calling 9-1-1.
