5 YEAR ROAD PLAN

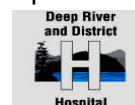

TIPPING FEES FOR BAGG'S ROAD LANDFILL

1 or 2 bags of garbage any vehicle	free
Mattresses, stuffed couches, chairs etc	\$10 each
Any vehicle OR trailer	\$10
Any vehicle AND trailer	\$20
Trucks larger than one ton*	\$12/cu yd
Hydrocarbon contaminated soil**	\$15/cu yd
Scrap metal cardboard, blue box items	free
All tires on or off rims	free
Household Hazardous waste	free
Electric and electrical equipment	free
Brush	free
Leaf, grass, garden waste (separated from brush)	free

*Fees for mattresses, stuffed couches, chairs, love seats etc must be paid and are per item **Must have completed analysis and be approved by the Coordinator (613-584-9194)
Fees can be paid at the Bagg's Road site or Town office.

MILLER ROAD C&D WASTE DISPOSAL SITE HOURS

Tuesday to Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Permits must be obtained from Deep River Town Office during their regular business hours. Construction and demolition waste is defined as all non-hazardous low metal content waste from construction and demolition clean up projects, consisting primarily of; wood, blocks/stone/bricks, non-metal roofing material, insulation, waste furniture (does not include mattresses and box springs), window glass, non metal siding material, concrete and small amounts of plastic and fiberglass. A Word from the Fire Chief...

Important Information Regarding STYROFOAM

The following items are **NOT** acceptable for recycling. Blue or pink rigid insulation (e.g. packing around new TV's) pipe insulation and packing peanuts, soft/bendable foam. They should be placed with your **regular garbage**. Meat trays with plastic covering and absorbent pads that are removed **ARE** acceptable with regular recycling. Rigid foam that is free of tape is acceptable as well.

Thousands of tonnes of waste electronics are generated each year in Ontario. Upwards of 90% of their component parts can be recycled. Less than 40% of Ontarians actually recycle their old electronics. Please do your part. ecyclepledge.recycleyourelectronics.ca

URGENT MEASURES NEEDED FOR BAGGS ROAD LANDFILL!

2012 was a bad year for the Baggs Rd Landfill. The volume filled was **20% higher** than the average of the five previous years. **50%** of materials in garbage bags destined to be landfilled are actually RECYCLABLE. Reducing, reusing, recycling and composting will extend the life of our current landfill site, saving us tax dollars. **50%** of the materials in the garbage bags that are being landfilled are recyclable. With the value of landfill volume estimated at \$78 per cubic meter, this means the lost value of landfill volume for 2012 alone is about **\$240,000!** This loss will soon translate into money that we will have to pay through our taxes if a new landfill must be found. This cost will be more than 2.5 million. Bag limits may be considered by the Town to encourage people that don't recycle to begin.
